

Beech Class Learning Plan



Literacy

To start Literacy off this term we will be focusing on our sentence structure. We will be looking at the different types of sentences and the different punctuation these sentences need. We will then be moving on to writing a diary entry using the Journal of Illiona: A young slave as our inspiration.

Maths

In maths this term we will be looking at the place value of number - what is the value of each digit in a number. We will look at addition and subtraction and multiplication and division facts and families.

Science

In science, our topic will be living things. We will be classifying living things and looking at their habitats. We will also be thinking about how living things adapt to their habitats.

Geography/History.

In Geography, we will be finding the answer to 'How has nature changed Dunwich?' To do this we will be identifying key physical features of Dunwich and looking at how erosion has impacted Dunwich.

Computing

In computing the focus will be networks and the World Wide Web. What is a website? In the second term we will be looking at creating animations.

Music

In Music we will be singing sea shanty songs that link to our Dunwich learning. We will also be thinking about the history and social context of some music.

Art / D.T.

Our art this term will focus on using clay to convey emotion in faces. Whilst in DT we will be using our sewing skills to make a map of Dunwich.

P.E.

In PE we will be starting the term focusing on the skills needed to play different types of invasion games and net/wall games. We will be working on their agility, balance and coordination through these skills

R.S.H.E.

We will be finding the answers to these questions 'Is being strong the same as being healthy?' And 'How can we influence people's happiness?'

Modern Foreign Languages.

We will be answering the question 'How can we describe people and places?' We will be looking at a range of different nationalities and learning numbers 1-10 in French.
