Literacy

We will begin the Autumn term by focusing on basic sentence structure. We will practice the use of capital letters, full stops, and finger spaces, while also ensuring that we form our letters correctly and align them with the lines.

Maths

Blocks in maths this term are the place value of numbers within 10 for year one and within 20 for year two. We then move onto addition and subtraction and finally look at the properties of 2D and 3D shapes in geometry.

Science

In Science, we will be learning about the human body and its parts. In addition, we will be exploring seasonal changes and spending time examining living things and their habitats.

Specifically, what habitats are like in autumn.

Geography

In Geography, we will learn about how humans have changed our local area. This will involve developing our locational knowledge through the use of fieldwork and observational skills. We will examine the coast, towns, and cities and explore landmarks, as well as human and physical features

Computing

We start by considering the technology that is around us and how to use this safely. Then we will work on using a digital paint programme to get creative.

Music

Using percussion, and considering different types of music and songs, we are looking at how we can represent the characters of the Mr Men using music.

After half term we will begin our preparations for the Key Stage One Christmas performance.

Art in the first half of the term considers whether art forms of humans need to look real. This is done by exploring Picasso's work and looking at creating masks and clay heads.
