Confident Communicators

Wellbeing Masters

Wellbeing is core to our Early Years Curriculum.

This term we will continue to develop friendships, learning how to engage in deeper play and challenge others choices.

Writing Superheros and Reading Wizards.

In phonics we will continue using Little Wandle working on recapping and reviewing phase 2. We will also continue teaching phase 3 phonemes.

Children will continue to bring home reading books and books to read for pleasure.

Our goal for this term is for everyone to develop a love for books and reading.

Maths Megastars

In Maths we will continue to develop number sense thinking deeply about the composition of number, cardinality; the quantity a number represents and ordinality; where numbers come and their relationships to each other.

In shape space and measure we will be looking at 2D and 3D shape and their properties.

We will use the language of shape: 2D 3D, flat, solid, corners, edges, vertices.

Ingenious Investigators

We will use the children's interests to support learning in all areas. During the Autumn term some children expressed an interest in some well known stories so this term we are going to be focusing on traditional tales.

Chinese New Year, Shrove Tuesday, Lent Ramadan and Easter will provide opportunities for looking at festivals.

Captain Creative

We will continue to learn a new rhyme each week to support our literacy and creativity.

Children will be exposed to opportunities to be creative through their play, making and building models with construction and art materials linked to the stories that we read.

Community Warrior's, Personal Improvers and Creative me.

We will use Rosa Parks as a key figure to support our character education in being determined and resilient and understanding and respecting equality and diversity.
