Year 3 & 4: Horstead Centre

We are very excited to share the details about our Year 3-4 residential for 2024.

We have decided to attend Horstead Centre for our Year 3-4 residential this year which will take place on 7th to 9th May where we will be staying for two nights. We will have opportunities to extend our curriculum and enhance their team building and problem solving skills using the fantastic outdoor facilities and learning with their experienced staff. The total cost will be £172 which includes all the food from the evening meal on Monday, all the meals Tuesday and up to lunchtime on Wednesday, the cost of the activities and instructional coaches and the travel costs to and from Horstead.

Should you wish your son/daughter to participate please give your consent on Arbor/trips and make the £30 deposit to secure a place for your child. Please note that payments for cost of residential visits are non refundable except in exceptional circumstances. It is vital that we pay the deposit for this trip asap to secure our place as demand for this experience is high. We will need to receive a further £60 by the end of January and the remaining balance of £82 by the beginning of April please.

We appreciate that it is the run up to Christmas and everything is expensive so we wanted to let you know about this as soon as we could and allow part payments to spread the costs. If you live in Hoxne it may be helpful to approach The Maynard Trust as they have helped with educational visits in the past or www.themothersunion.org who offer help with breaks away for families.
